

A.C.T. TEST PREPARATION WORKSHOPS

Fall, 2012 Through Spring, 2013

Description: All locations are open to all students, grades 9-12. These widely acclaimed five-hour workshops help students prepare for the national and state-mandated "ACT with Writing" test. Students will:

- Learn specifically how one's ACT score and GPA impact college admission and scholarships.
- Learn proven ACT test-taking strategies and essay strategies.
- Take an authentic, full-length (3½ hours), timed ACT practice test and essay.
- Build ACT test familiarity, pacing skill, and confidence, and may reduce test stress.
- Receive their practice test scores at the workshop. Parents are emailed test and essay scores.
- Learn a highly effective method for correcting and understanding ACT test errors. It is designed to help students take ownership and significantly improve their scores (often 3-8 points) on any follow-up practice or live ACT test. All ACT tests have similar timing, format and content!

Students must bring a watch, two #2 pencils and a non-texting calculator, and may bring a light snack and bottled water.
