- June 7** **Senior Honors Convocation** at 6:00 p.m. This event will be in the LHS Gym. Reporting time will be 5:30 p.m. for alignment.
- June 8** **Baccalaureate** at 6:00 p.m. in the LHS Auditorium.
- June 9** **Swing-Out** will be held jointly with Community High School at 6:00 p.m. Reporting time will be **5:30 p.m.** for alignment. Students are to park at the East end of downtown and assemble at the Lapeer Insurance Agency.
- June 12** **Commencement** at Dort Financial Event Center at 2:00 p.m. Seniors will need to arrive by **12:30 p.m.** and report to the lower level. Each graduate will receive 9 tickets.

Commencement is intended to be a community event to recognize our students. Cap and gown colors are blue and green, boys will be in blue and girls will be in green. Graduation is a formal ceremony to recognize the achievement of students who have earned a Lapeer High School diploma. Students will be expected to dress and act appropriately. Students will get additional information at their senior meeting.

## FOOD SERVICE NEWS

### LCS Families—

Below are some updates we wanted to communicate to our families regarding the end of the current 2021-2022 school year, as well as the upcoming 2022-2023 school year.

**BREAKFAST:** Breakfast is always free to all students. Each morning students will have the opportunity to eat at school. This will continue for the 2022-2023 school year.

**LUNCH:** For the last year, we have been operating under a grant from the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) allowing us to feed lunch to all students for free. As of right now, the USDA Nationwide Waivers are set to end June 30, 2022. This means that our pricing structure will return for the 2022-2023 school year.

**2022-2023 FREE/REDUCED MEALS APPLICATION:** Regardless of the waiver status referred to above, we are still asking families to fill out the free/reduced meals application if you think you may qualify as the information aids us in obtaining other district funding. Both **online** and paper applications for the 2022-2023 school year will become **available after July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022**. Applications are located in all district building offices.

**SUPPLY CHAIN INTERRUPTIONS:** As you may have heard, supply chain interruptions are impacting many trades nationwide. The LCS food service department is currently among those dealing with unavailable items or last-minute replacements. Please understand that menus are subject to change due to these shortages. We will do our best to notify families of changes. We appreciate your patience!

**ALLERGIES:** LCS takes all food allergies seriously. However, at times with the current nationwide supply chain issues, we're having to change lunch ingredients in the middle of lunch service and are doing our best to monitor allergies at the line. If your student knows they have an allergy, please have them speak up.

**SUMMER FOOD PROGRAM:** LCS is one of many partners that participate in the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) Summer Food Service Program. *Meet Up and Eat Up* provides free nutritious meals to children and teens up to age 18 at no charge. Watch for more information to come as summer approaches.
