CHECKING STUDENT BALANCES

You can view your students account balance by using the student lunch account portal at lapeer.familyportal.cloud. In addition to viewing balances, this will give you access to filling out a free or reduced lunch application, viewing your students account history, transferring money between students, or setting parental spending controls. Once on the homepage, use the "Register" button to create an account. For further account setup instructions, click the Student Lunch Account Portal link on the left side of the page (click the "+" sign on the green Food Service Department toolbar to expand links if viewing on mobile device).

DEPOSITING MONEY TO A STUDENTS ACCOUNT

To deposit money to a student's account, you will utilize the PaySchools Central payment system at payschoolscentral.com. For your convenience, there is a link on the left side of the page that includes quick access to the system and a parent user guide (click the "+" sign on the green Food Service Department toolbar to expand links if viewing on mobile device). PaySchools Central was updated in the summer of 2021. Therefore, if you have not used it since then, you will need to create a new account. Once your account is set up, you will need your student's 5-digit student ID number to add them to your account for deposits.
