Congratulations to 79 AP Scholars at LHS

Seventy-nine (79) students at Lapeer High School have earned AP Scholar Awards in recognition of their exceptional achievement on AP Exams for the 2016-17 school year.

The College Board's Advanced Placement Program® (AP®) provides willing and academically prepared students with the opportunity to take rigorous college-level courses while still in high school, and to earn college

credit, advanced placement, or both for successful performance on the AP Exams. About 18 percent of the more than 2.5 million students worldwide who took AP Exams performed at a sufficiently high level to also earn an AP Scholar Award. The College Board recognizes several levels of achievement based on students' performance on AP Exams.

At Lapeer High School:

Two (2) students qualified as a National AP Scholars by earning at least a four on all AP Exams taken, and scores of 4 or higher on eight or more of these exams. Previously only two students had earned this distinction in district history. Congratulations to both David Bellinger (12th) and Alexa Ringle (12th) on this achievement.

Eighteen (18) students qualified for the AP Scholar with Distinction Award by earning

an average score of at least 3.5 on all AP Exams taken, and scores of 3 or higher on five or more of these exams.
